

Dear Campus Customers:

Central Plant will be conducting a regularly scheduled high temperature hot water shutdown the weekend of Friday, March 21, 2025, through Sunday, March 23, 2025.

We will be shutting down just after 12:00a.m. on Friday, March 21, 2025. Normal service will be restored no later than Sunday, March 23, 2025, at 11:00p.m.

The purpose of this shutdown is to conduct regularly scheduled maintenance of equipment on the high temperature hot water system and the cogeneration plant. The systems that will be affected during the shutdown will include building heat, industrial & domestic hot water, and steam generation for cage washers and autoclaves.

The chilled water supply for the buildings and process cooling will **not** be affected during this shutdown.

This maintenance will help ensure that we provide reliable service to the campus community.
